Recycling Temporarily Closed

Guadalupe County has temporarily closed the **recycling** stations in the county including the one on FM 2438 in Kingsbury.

As of our Regularly Scheduled Meeting, July 30, 2019, the Guadalupe County Commissioners Court voted to Re-Bid (Request For Proposal 19-4072) for the operations of the Guadalupe County Collection Stations.
















Keeping Kool


That says it all, doesn't it?!

Kingsbury News Past

All the **news** that's fit to print about what was happening in Kingsbury . . .

The July 22, 1875 edition of the San Antonio Daily Express had the Arrivals and Departures of people on the Austin stagecoach and the Kingsbury stagecoach. Kingsbury was still the last station on the Galveston Harrisburg & San Antonio railroad from Houston and you had to pick up the stage to get any further west.



Arrivate and Departures.

Mr. Hewitt, CF Stewart, Frank Trainor.

Arrivals from Kingsbury:

Mrs Morris, E Newman, A C McKenn, C More, E B Hayes, Barny Talley.

Departures by Austin Stage:

Liont. Hoffmann, Mr Gresham and wife, E H Hart, W S Manson, Mrs Schmidt.

Departures by Kingsbury Stage:

E Johnson, Ljent. Torry.

Also in 1875, you can get a meal at Dietrich's for "25 and 50 cts." or you can stay there where they have "a good camp yard" (the "A" is upside down in YARD), Nic. Tengg has books and newspapers in German and English, and Saratoga Baths has a Ladies Saloon for "25 cents extra" and is open from 3 to 8 for "Ladies and their escorts (in full bathing costumes)". Don't forget that bathing costume! The Alamo Stable not only has livery and buggies but also ambulances and hearses, Bell & Bros. has "fine pocket and table cutlery" (table cutlery I get, but what is pocket cutlery?), and Mr. Leal has "another arrival of sheep". There's fresh fish (or "fishes" as it says here) at Military Plaza that are "alive and kicking", and get your meal ground from your own corn at Laux's Steam-Mill.

Welding, cutting, and grinding or any activity that causes a spark




Burning household trash
