Southern Pacific Excursion for Visit of Naval Vessels.

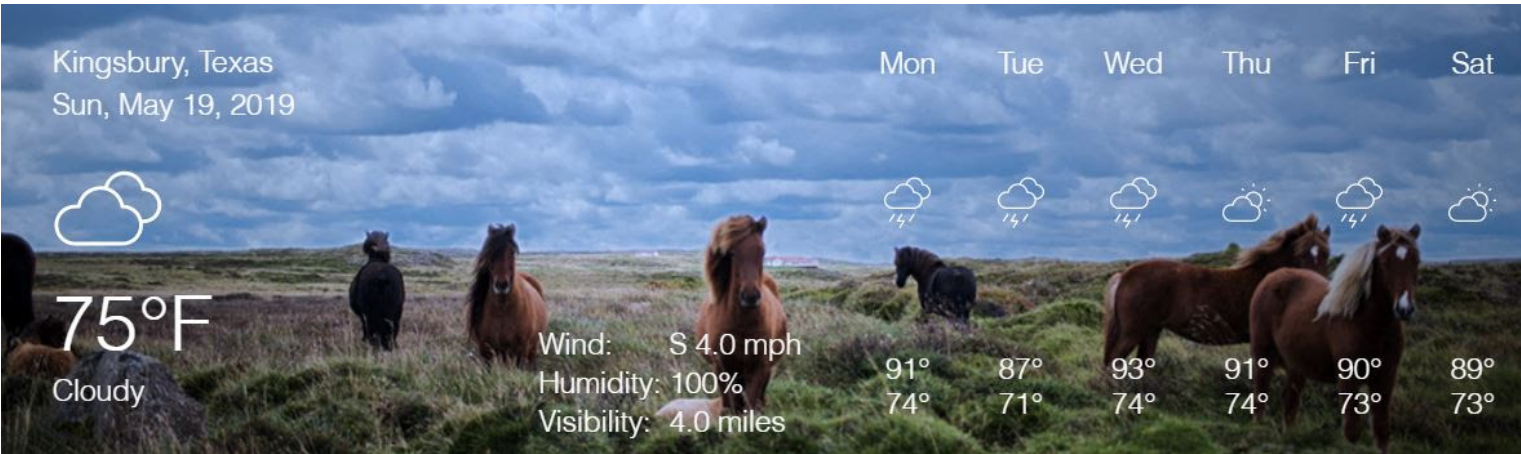
On the Galveston, Harrisburg and San Antonio tickets will be sold for trains leaving San Antonio April 9, good to return on any train of April 10 and 11. The following are the rates authorized:

On the Texas and New Orleans tickets will be sold for trains leaving Orange April 9, limited to return on any train of April 10 and 11. Following are the rates:

Orange	\$2 00	Raywood	1 25
Terry	2 00	Ames	1 25
Beaumont ...	1 75	Liberty	1 00
China	1 75	Dayton	1 00
