




Kingsbury News Past

The April 6, 1904 edition of the *Houston Post* reported on the rates for a special excursion train to Galveston "for Visit of Naval Vessels." It cost you \$3.50 to travel from Kingsbury to see torpedo boat destroyers and the "flagship Minneapolis".



In other 1904 news, there was a kind of road rage incident with wagons that left one man dead, I wonder what the "successful method" is that's going to "enlarge your bust six inches", it's "Panama Hat Time", and someone in the Fifth ward has a "nice pony" thats "not afraid of cars". Probably very handy in the time where cars and horses were sharing the road.

If you're not into Panama hats, K.G. Welch has "street hats", I don't know what to make of this Joe Devine ad (it was under Personals), if you don't want a new Panama hat or a street hat, the Houston Hat Co. can make your old hat new, and van Houten's cocoa will give you "strength and energy". All meetings are now held at the Kingsbury Volunteer Fire Station at 1060 FM 1104.


